**Maths - Mata Beo pg 96**, the children can use the x and dots method that I showed in the video last week **4....**

**English** – Listen to the **video called O and U pg 41-43**, then the children can do pages **41, 42, 43** in **Onwords and Upwords**, on page **42** , the children read the story again.

**Dé Céadaoin – Gaeilge** – Listen to the video on the website called **Bó bó video**, then the children can do pages **59 in the book Ag Obair Liom**. The sentence that the children write on this page is **Seo é Bó bó an fear grinn**. You can write it on a piece of paper for your child to copy into their books. Afterwards the children can read over pages **1-10** again in the book **Lúsaí**.

**Maths** - listen to the video called **Mata Beo pg 97**, after watching the video the children can proceed to complete **page 97** in their books .

**English – Onwords and Upwords page 44** The children read the words and draw the pictures.

**Déardaoin - Gaeilge** – Listen to the video on the website called **Lúsaí 3**, after viewing the video, see if your child can read pages **11-13** again with your help. Then in the **Learn to write B2** copy write the sentence

**Tá bó ag ól cócó.**

The children write the same sentence six times copying the one you wrote at the top.

Make sure your child is forming the words properly, that they are doing their capitals and leaving space between words. Also get the children to read the sentence before they start writing going over the **ó words**.

**Maths** - listen to the video called **Mata Beo pg 98**, after watching the video the children can proceed to complete **page 98** in their books .

**Féach Thart** - Listen to the video called **Féach Thart An Luch**, after watching the video the children can complete the page shown in the video in their book **Féach Thart**

**Dé hAoine - Gaeilge** – Listen to the video called **Lúsaí 4**, after viewing the video see if your child can read pages 14-16 again with your help. Afterwards the children can colour the page I referred to in the video, **the first page of photocopy pack I sent home based on the book Lusaí**
